Plan Approval Description

This plan approval is for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a new natural gas compressor station (with a design throughput of 250 million cubic feet per day) and metering station, and the operation and maintenance of an existing metering station, at an existing facility. The compressor station is intended to increase the pressure of natural gas from an existing pipeline from approximately 820 psig to 1,080 psig.
