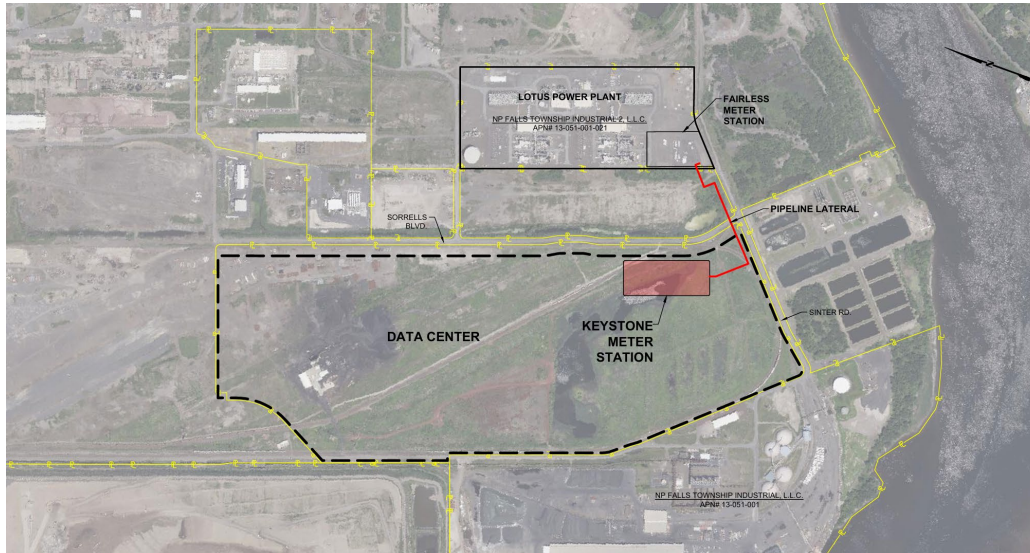
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What is a Meter Station?

Meter Stations



Often referred to as the city gate, a meter station is the point where distribution companies and major users receive gas from transmission pipelines. Meter stations measure the flow of gas along the pipeline, using specialized meters to not impede the gas movement.
