Dear Mr. Fullee:

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is conducting an assessment of the Bishop Tube site located in East Whiteland Township, Chester County. I spoke to Mr. Kent Lulewich of Damascus Bishop Tube (current site operators) who indicated that Christiana Metals is the owner of the site property and is responsible for cleanup of the site. I was unable to contact you at the phone number which Mr. Lulewich provided. I am aware that the Department (Water Management Program) had been tracking investigation activities conducted by BCM Engineers at the site. I have been unable to find recent information regarding the investigation or cleanup of the site in the Department's files.

The Department would like to obtain any more recent information you may have regarding investigation or cleanup activities at the Bishop Tube site to determine if hazardous substances released at the site warrant a response under the Pennsylvania Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act ("HSCA"), the Act 108 of October 18, 1988, 35 P.S. §§ 6020.101 *et seq.* Under Section 503 of HSCA, 35 P.S. § 6020.503, the Department has the authority to gain access and gather information "...for the purposes of determining the need for response, choosing or taking a response action under the act or otherwise enforcing the provisions of the act."

Please call me to discuss the status of the site cleanup at (610) 832-6206. I will prepare a memo based on any information you can provide to bring the Water Management Program up-to-date.
