Mr. Love:

The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is seeking information concerning a release and/or threat of release of hazardous substances into the environment from the former Bishop Tube Company in Frazier, East Whiteland Township, Chester County, now known as the Bishop Tube Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act site (Site). The Site is located on Malin Road just south of U.S. Route 30, Frazer, PA.

The Department's records indicate that Safety-Kleen had a service contract¹ with a business located at Malin Road just south of U.S. Route 30, Frazer, PA. The business was, at all relevant times to the Department's investigation, known by the following names:

Because Safety-Kleen had a service contract with the aforementioned company at the Site, Safety-Kleen may have information relevant to the release of hazardous substances at the Site. Section 6020.103, which were generated, treated, stored, disposed, transported to, or released at the Site.

Specifically, your response to this request should include, but not be limited to, the following:

1. Documentation regarding the types and quantities of hazardous substances, or materials containing hazardous substances which were disposed of, stored, treated, spilled or released into the soil, groundwater or surface water at the Site. Please use specific chemical names rather than generic terms, such as "solvents" or "liquid wastes." Please also describe the manner and the location in which any of the above materials were disposed of, stored, treated, spilled or released into the soil, groundwater or surface waters at the Site.
2. Documentation regarding the approximate dates such hazardous substances or materials containing hazardous substances, were disposed of, stored, treated, spilled or released at the Site.
3. Documentation concerning how such hazardous substances or materials containing hazardous substances were treated, transported to, stored or disposed of at the Site.
4. Documentation regarding the identity and address of any other person or company which generated, treated, stored, transported or disposed of hazardous substances or materials containing hazardous substances at the Site.
5. Documentation regarding the assets and liabilities of any of the entities listed on page one of this letter.
