I want the Bishop Tube site in the Malvern/Frazer PA contaminated site fully remediated to the highest legal standards by all responsible parties, and for the site once cleaned up to remain protected as an open space for the community in perpetuity. This is to include the removal of all long term sources of contamination. This clean up must be done in a way not to further degrade the Little Valley Creek. All toxic materials like Trichloroethene (TCE), Vinyl Chloride, and Hexavalent Chromium must be addressed and the best remedy selected. The cleanup must include protecting the air from contamination. Ongoing monitoring of the air, bedrock and water should be maintained for years.

Building homes or any other building on this site would negatively impact the environment and community. The state needs to do what is right for the people that live and work in this community.
