Why: Energy Transfer Marketing & Terminals, L.P. (ETMT; formally Sunoco Partners Marketing & Terminals, L.P. [SPMT]), processes, stores, and distributes natural gas liquids (NGLs) at its Marcus Hook Terminal (MHT), located at 100 Green Street, Marcus Hook, PA 19061, in Marcus Hook Borough, Delaware County.

The NGLs operations at the MHT are currently permitted under two existing Plan Approvals, while the rest of the operations at the facility are permitted under a Title V Operating Permit. ETMT has proposed to expand the ethane chilling capacity at the MHT from approximately 75,000 barrels per day (bpd) to approximately 85,000 bpd.

ETMT has applied for a Plan Approval (No. 23-0119K) from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to ensure that the Ethane Chilling Expansion Project meets all applicable Commonwealth and federal rules, regulations, and requirements.

The DEP will be providing a brief explanation and allow for questions and answers before taking official public comments for the record.
