Dear Mr. Smith:

Energy Transfer Marketing & Terminals L.P. (ETMT) submits this letter to request a Plan Approval Extension for Plan Approval 23-0119J for the Marcus Hook Terminal. Please note that this letter is intended to update and supersede our letter dated November 17, 2023, in which ETMT requested an extension to the date for commencement of construction of the sources authorized under Plan Approval 23-0119J. ETMT has decided to commence construction at this time, and therefore is no longer requesting an extension on that basis; however, Plan Approval 23-0119J expires on February 12, 2024, and therefore a plan approval extension is requested to allow for the completion of construction in accordance with Condition B.006(b) of the Plan Approval.

ETMT is planning to begin foundation work for the sources authorized by Plan Approval 23-0119J during the week of January 29, 2024. The construction schedule for this project, which is included as an attachment to this letter, indicates that construction will require a 3-year timeframe. ETMT respectfully requests PADEP to currently authorize an 18-month extension to Plan Approval 23-0119J until August 12, 2025.

The emission sources proposed as a part of Plan Approval 23-0119J will continue to meet current Best Available Control Technology (BACT) Standards. A BACT analysis was recently reviewed by PADEP for the pending Plan Approval 23-0119K application, and the requirements of Plan Approval 23-0119K will apply to Plan Approval 23-0119J sources. Therefore, no further analysis is needed.

A copy of the Plan Approval Extension Form, the Air Quality Fee Schedule, and the anticipated construction schedule is attached to this letter as well as a copy of the previously submitted check for \$750.


