Dear Mr. Bryan:

Under the authority of Pennsylvania's Clean Streams Law, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has approved your request for amendment of coverage under the Erosion and Sediment Control (E&S) Permit. The latest versions of the permit applications and all supporting documents, including the Erosion and Sediment Control (E&S) Plan and Post-Construction Stormwater Management (PCSM) Plan, are incorporated into this approval, including the following plan drawings:

- The Erosion and Sediment Control Plan drawings, for the Marsh Creek Lake Sediment Remediation, dated December 23, 2021, and last revised March 17, 2022.
- The Site Restoration Plan drawings, for the Marsh Creek Lake Sediment Remediation, dated December 23, 2021, and last revised March 17, 2022.

Your coverage under the E&S Permit will continue through Permit No. ESG0100015001. If stormwater discharges associated with oil and gas activities are expected to continue beyond the expiration date of your E&S Permit coverage, you must apply to renew your coverage at least 180 days prior to the expiration date.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board), pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:

Appeals must be filed with the Board within 30 days of receipt of notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.


