Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of November 26, 2019, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

Hanson Aggregates has submitted two items to DEP for its review: A Qualitative Geologic Survey Report, submitted November 15, 2019 and a copy of a letter from their consultants, RJ Lee Group regarding asbestos and application regulations, submitted November 25, 2019. DEP is reviewing both of these items, along with all previously submitted material. DEP is still waiting on a final response from the PA Department of Health with answers to questions asked by DEP about asbestos.

The Qualitative Geologic Survey and RJ Lee Group letter have both been updated to the Rock Hill webpage:
