Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of October 14, 2020, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

Since the last community update sent on September 21, 2020:

- [DEP offices](#) remain closed to prevent the further spread of COVID-19. Staff continue to work remotely, conducting inspections as needed to protect the health and safety of the residents of the Commonwealth, reviewing reports, and otherwise carrying out the mission and work of the Department.
- Hanson will be on site Thursday, October 15 to conduct approved hydroseeding in four areas identified in their September 18, 2020 Site Revegetation letter, which is posted to the website. This activity is only expected to take a single day to complete and will be overseen by a DEP inspector. Hanson will not be using earth moving equipment and will adhere to a reduced speed limit of 15 mph.
- DEP continues to review and post all correspondence and supplemental submissions received.
