Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of August 29, 2019, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

On August 21, 2019, DEP received laboratory reports for DEP's independent core drilling and boulder sampling. DEP will continue to review the results and evaluate the appropriate methodology used in collecting and testing the samples to determine the next steps. A possible next step may be the retesting of prior samples by Hanson using a methodology similar to what DEP used for its samples.

As a reminder, there is **NO** active mining at the site as DEP continues to assess and evaluate the conditions at the quarry.
