You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of May 5, 2022, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

This email is to provide notice that Hanson personnel will be on site Monday, May 9, 2022 to install an autonomous weather station utilizing a man-lift. No digging or earth disturbance will take place. Hanson will obey a speed limit of 15 MPH to prevent dust emissions and DEP will be on site to monitor all activity.
