You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of September 30, 2022, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

This email is to provide notice that Activity Based Sampling events 2 and 5 (equipment delivery and site maintenance activities), which was scheduled to occur today, September 30, has been **postponed** due to overload issues with the battery-operated air monitors. Future sampling efforts will include the use of small generators and electric power to prevent these issues from occurring again.

DEP will send a community update when a new date has been selected.
