General Comments

Arrived on site at approximately 9:20 am to observe Limited Activity Air Sampling Event No. 1 as approved by the Department in a letter dated February 28, 2022. Hanson's consultants arrived on site at 7 am to place the air monitoring stations around the permit (see photo for locations). At about 10:30 am, three Hanson employees began driving around the site near the 8 established air monitoring stations at speeds below 15 MPH. The Hanson employees continued driving for 2.5 hours. Mr. Kristian Witt and Mr. Peter Schlenker from Compliance Management International checked the air monitoring stations every hour. Air Quality Specialist Jennifer Ramos-Buschman was on site to observe the activity for about 2 hours. Hanson will submit the air sampling results to the Department as soon as they become available.

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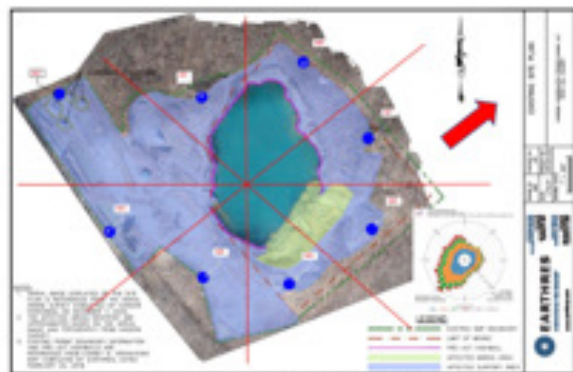


Figure 1. Rock Hill quarry site map with sample collection locations indicated with blue dots. Prevailing wind direction during July 6, 2021 sampling indicated by red arrow at upper right of map. Average wind speed 2.8 mph during sampling.
