During a site visit on March 22, 2019, discolored (tan) water was observed discharging from the sediment pond in the SE corner of the permit (Sediment trap #1). This is a violation of 25 Pa. Code Chapter 102 and permit conditions which incorporate the former 25 Pa. Code Chapter 77.102(c)(1), therefore a Notice of Violation is issued. The operator shall construct and maintain Sediment trap #1 in accordance with the approved plans and the regulations. The operator should submit to the Department, for approval, any changes made to the										
design and or maintenance of Sediment trap #1. The operator should complete this work on or before May 3, 2019.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. Section 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S. Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, Box 8457, 400 Market Street, P.O. Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, 717-787-3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800-654-5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal may be obtained from the Board. At 717-787-3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.
