On site May 1, 2019 at 9 am to observe core drilling. Drill set on first hole around 10 am. No dust observed during drilling. Three water tanks filled by the water truck for use while drilling. Haul road was wet prior to moving drill rig. No dust observed during travel. Left site around 3 pm.

On site May 2, 2019 at 9 am to observe drilling. Left the site around 10 am to conduct inspections on nearby quarries. Returned to the site around 12:30 pm. Left site around 3:10 pm. No dust observed during drilling.

On site May 3, 2019 at 9 am to observe drilling. Left site around 2:30 pm.

On site May 7, 2019 at 8:45 am to observe drilling. Left site at 10:03 am. Returned to site 12:18 pm. Left site at 3:06 pm.

On site May 10, 2019 around 11 am. No drilling today. Reviewed cores with ERG and DEP personnel. Left site around 2 pm.

On site May 14, 2019 around 11:30 am to observe drilling. Left site around 3 pm.

On site May 15, 2019 around 9 am to observe drilling. Drilling finished about 12 pm and I left the site around 12:30 pm.

For each visit noted above, no dust was observed during drilling or travel on site.
