Thank you for your letter of January 28, 2020, regarding the Rock Hill Quarry located at 2055 North Rockhill Road, Sellersville, East Rockhill Township. The Department appreciates your concern for the citizens of this Commonwealth, especially those residing near the quarry. The Department also takes seriously its responsibility to the citizens of the Commonwealth. The Department immediately ceased mining operations at the quarry as soon as asbestos was detected at the quarry.

The Department appreciates input from stakeholders in its decision-making process. We give thoughtful consideration to all the information we receive from all parties. The Pottsville District Mining Office is preparing comments regarding the quarry's most recent report on asbestos concentrations at the quarry.
