## **NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

Dear Mr. Landis:

On May 23, 2018, I conducted an inspection of the above facility and noted the following violation(s):

Richard E. Pierson Materials Corp. poured foundations for the primary crusher, installed structural steel for the primary crusher feed hopper, and brought associated equipment such as conveyors and screen components on-site at the above facility without a valid, issued plan approval or operating permit from the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). This is a violation of 25 Pa. Code Section 127.11.

Please submit a detailed abatement plan no later than 15 days from receipt of this letter explaining why this violation occurred and how you will prevent similar violations from occurring in the future.

Any violation of DEP's Air Quality Regulations subjects a person to a variety of enforcement actions, including civil and criminal penalties. Each day the violation continues constitutes a separate offense.

During the inspection, I was told that the primary crusher is planned to be delivered the week of May 28, 2018. Please be aware that continued construction of sources requiring a plan approval, including bringing those sources and associated equipment on-site, would constitute ongoing and additional violations of 25 Pa. Code Sections 127.11.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of DEP. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action available to DEP under any of its statutes. If DEP determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action.
