
Pending Permits

- Received NPDES renewal application in late
 June 2012 no decision made
 - Solebury Township was copied on application
 - Solebury Township was copied on correspondence

Permit Actions

- Issued emergency permits to repair sinkholes in Primrose Creek
- Issued minor revision to authorize stream work
- Issued GP-104 stormwater management permit for stream work
- Issued bond increment to upgrade bond to current liability amount

PCWA & PennFuture Settlement



PCWA & PennFuture Settlement

- NHCS Obligations
 - Perform stream restoration work
 - Different segments prioritized:
 - swallet area (instream sinkholes)
 - Downstream of swallet area to quarry
 - Upstream to School property
 - Additional discharge monitoring (TSS)
 - Weekly sampling or within 24 hours of a 1-year, 24-hr storm
 - Currently ongoing
 - PECO culvert clean out

PCWA & PennFuture Settlement

- PADEP Obligations
 - Require additional discharge monitoring (TSS) in next NPDES permit
 - Weekly sampling or within 24 hours of a 1-year, 24-hr storm
 - Currently ongoing
 - Provide PCWA and PennFuture 30 days to comment on restoration work
 - Will provide response to comments not being addressed by PADEP actions

Complaints

- 3rd Quarter 2015 blasting complaint
 - Shot in compliance
 - Department seismograph placed at location never registered vibrations
- 4th Quarter 2015 blasting and dust complaint
 - Shot in compliance
 - Department seismograph placed at location never registered vibrations

Complaints

- 4th Quarter 2015 blasting complaint
 - Investigated by blasting inspector
 - Shot in compliance
- No well complaints reported to Pottsville
 Office

 - 4th quarter 2015
 - Sinkholes repaired by NHCS and Spectra Energy


New Hope Crushed Stone PA DEP Sample Locations





Primrose Creek Basin-Wide Average Total Suspended Solids*




Monitoring Well Elevations at New Hope Crushed Stone and Lime Co., Inc. SMP# 7974SM3

Elevation ft MSL



Inspections & Violations

- October 2015 compliance order
 - Reclamation plan to abate the nuisance based on time needed, not based on mineable reserves
 - Quarry flooding schedule
 - Installation of well on Solebury School
 - Stream restoration work timetable

Inspections & Violations

- August 2016 compliance order
 - Failure to conduct the reclamation and abatement on schedule
- Inspection reports forwarded to Solebury Twp.

EHB Activities

- Rescinded the depth correction
- No mining below -120' MSL level
- Abate the nuisance
- PADEP did not appeal
- NHCS appealed, then withdrew its appeal
- EHB hearing in May 2016 denied NHCS' petition for a supersedeas
- Hearing scheduled for March 2017 for appeal of January 29, 2016 letter

PADEP Plans

- Review NPDES renewal application
- Enforce the EHB adjudication
- Defending the appeal of the January 2016 letter

Numbers

- 500,000 gallons per day
 - Minimum pumping volume, requested by Solebury Township
- 98' and 48' MSL
 - Projected post-mining water level
 - Chapter 77.594 requires reclamation slopes to extend 50 feet lower
- \$1,144,029, \$356,200 and \$54,341
 - Posted bond under PILB
 - Amount paid in since
 - Current annual payment
