The Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") has reviewed the scope of work ("SOW") for the rehabilitation of the Muse-Bishop Road Site ("Site") in Cecil Township, Washington County received in this office on April 12, 2019. The SOW was submitted as part of the request under the Industrial Sites Reuse Program administered by the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development.

The Site is located at 288 Muse-Bishop Road in Cecil Township, Washington County. A Phase II Environmental Site Assessment will be conducted and will include any soil borings and soil gas/groundwater sampling necessary to address the identified recognized environmental conditions at the Site. The SOW indicated that the Site will be entered into the Department's Act 2 program.

The Department hereby approves the April 12, 2019 SOW for the referenced facility. It should be noted that this approval applies only to a general scope of work and does not apply to the detailed steps that were presented in the application (soil borings, monitoring wells, etc.).
