Floodplain Management and Stormwater Management Consistency Review

Sewickley Township, Westmoreland County

Dear Ms. Batoon:

A review of the above referenced project maps has been made. We recommend that the following comments be appropriately addressed before we recommend that the Sewickley Township Supervisors provide floodplain management consistency and stormwater management consistency letters for this project.

- 1. Erosion and Sedimentation Control (E&SC) Plans and accompanying E&SC report for the portion of the pipeline project through Sewickley Township should be submitted in order for us to complete our review to determine the plan's consistency with the Township's Floodplain Management Ordinance and Stormwater Management Ordinance.
- 2. Please note that prior to commencement of any land disturbance activities within Sewickley Township, a land disturbance application needs to be completed and submitted to the Township along with the appropriate application fee. The Building Permit Application Packet which includes the Land Disturbance/Stormwater Management application form can be downloaded from the Township's website at http://www.sewickleytownship.org/forms-shortcode.
- 3. As per §224.F of the Township's Buildings Ordinance, any materials that are stored within the 100-year floodplain that are buoyant, flammable, explosive or potentially injurious shall be stored at an elevation of at least two feet above the regulatory flood elevation and/or floodproofed to the maximum extent possible.

Our office reviews Stormwater Management and Land Disturbance Plan applications solely to determine compliance with the Sewickley Township Stormwater Management Ordinance as well as other relevant Township ordinances. Property and right-of-way owners are ultimately responsible for storm water leaving their site.
