Shell reported 2 hours, 9 minutes and 26 seconds of intermittent visible emissions observed between 9:42:27 and 15:52:00 on April 25, 2025, from the HP (High Pressure) Ground Flare #1 (Source C205A). Shell reported 34 minutes and 55 seconds of intermittent visible emissions observed between 10:00:25 and 15:49:33 on April 25, 2025, from the HP (High Pressure) Ground Flare #2 (Source C205B). Shell reported that these cumulative emissions exceeded 5 minutes in a consecutive 2-hour period. These malfunctions caused violations of PA-04-00740C and 25 Pa. Code §127.25.
