Hi Jen and Chris,

Barbara and I have both looked at the methodologies you send to us for the Shell Pipeline. I have no comments for archaeology. What you have proposed looks reasonable and I know that if you are surprised by anything once you get into your fieldwork you will be in touch to discuss it with me. Barbara has one comment for the above ground methods:

We are in agreement with methodology for identification of above ground historic properties. We request that for the delineation of the visual APEs at the proposed locations of the three compressor stations the APE be based on an examination of topography, changes in elevation and vegetative cover, and GIS based modeling. This will enable to APE to include only the anticipated extent to which a project may be visible from. The modeled APE should be checked during field survey and justified and documented in the identification report.

You can contact her directly if you have any questions about her comments – or, as always you can call me if you have anything you would like to discuss.

I am not planning on issuing a formal letter for this submission, but rather printing this email out for our file. If you would like a formal letter of letterhead please let me know and I will issue one when I am back in the office next week.
