Thank you for your bat survey addendum e-mailed to this office on August 9, 2017 due to the Falcon Project (2015-1047) reroute. Based on the results of this survey, Service comments of January 13, 2018 regarding Indiana bats and Northern long-eared bats are still valid.

Due to the presence of several Northern long-eared bat roost trees within the vicinity of the project footprint (although outside of the 150-foot buffer), we recommend the following *voluntary* conservation measure:

No tree removal between June 1 and July 31.
