2011 Great American Cleanup of PA **Summary Results**

Report Prepared and Submitted by Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful

Summary

The following statistics reflect results from the 2011 Great American Cleanup of PA (GACPA) activities reported to Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful (KPB) and PennDOT through June 15, 2011. All related activities were events registered with KPB during March, April, and May 2011 or through PennDOT's Adopt-A-Highway Program (AAH).

As of June 15, 2011, the reporting rate for GACPA registered events through the GACPA website was 70% (549 out of 783). Therefore, the actual grand totals could be significantly higher. There was a chance that some registrants reported their results twice through the GACPA website and through the regular reporting of the AAH program. Any possible duplication was considered insignificant and the totals were added together for the purposes of determining grand totals for the 2011 GACPA.

All 67 counties in Pennsylvania were represented in the Great American Cleanup of PA in 2011. There were 4,222 events with 159,922 volunteers. Volunteers collected 354,267 bags of trash or 7,085,340 pounds. They cleaned 13,140 miles of roads, railroad tracks, trails, waterways, and shorelines, and 5,887 acres of parks and or wetlands. Additionally, volunteers planted 3,321 trees, bulbs, and plants in an effort to keep Pennsylvania beautiful.

Highlights

- Registered Events and Volunteers Organizers in Lancaster County were leaders in the cleanup effort with 283 registered events followed by Bucks (215), Chester (163), Susquehanna (137), and Montgomery (136) Counties. Volunteers of registered events in these top five counties represented 15% of the total volunteers, accounting for 23,657 of the 159,922 volunteers.
- Pounds of Trash Volunteers in Philadelphia County collected the most trash with an impressive total of 2,076,340 pounds. Volunteers in Allegheny (947,960), Luzerne (448,360), Bucks (309,820), and Elk (219,400) Counties rounded out the top five counties for pounds of trash collected.
- *Miles Cleaned* Volunteers in Bucks County cleaned more roads, railroad tracks, trails, waterways, and shorelines than any other county with a total of 1,308 miles cleaned. Volunteers in Philadelphia (1,207), Lancaster (693), Chester (573), and Westmoreland (515) Counties rounded out the top five counties for mileage cleaned.
- Beautification Beautification efforts were most notable in the southeast region of the state with Philadelphia County volunteers planting a total of 727 trees, flowers, and bulbs. Lehigh County volunteers planted 605 of the same. On the western side of the state, Cambria County planted 502 trees, flowers, and bulbs. The volunteer beautification effort in these three counties accounted for 55% of all trees, flowers, and bulbs planted.
- Tires collected Philadelphia County volunteers collected 7,285 tires followed by Elk County volunteers with 1,491. Volunteers in Centre County collected 970 tires.
 Collections in these three counties accounted for 67% of all tires collected.
