2013 Great American Cleanup of PA Summary Results

Report Prepared and Submitted by Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful

Summary

The following statistics reflect results from the 2013 Great American Cleanup of PA (GACPA) activities reported to Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful (KPB) and PennDOT through June 15, 2013. All related activities were events registered with KPB during March, April, and May 2013 or through PennDOT's Adopt-A-Highway Program (AAH).

All 67 counties in Pennsylvania were represented in the Great American Cleanup of PA in 2013. As of June 15, 2013, the reporting rate for GACPA registered events through the GACPA website was 80% Therefore, the actual grand totals could be significantly higher. There were 4,928 events with 137,429 volunteers. Volunteers collected 309,672 bags of trash or 6,193,439 pounds. They cleaned 13,954 miles of roads, railroad tracks, trails, waterways, and shorelines, and 4,252 acres of parks and or wetlands. Additionally, volunteers planted 5,933 trees, bulbs, and plants in an effort to keep Pennsylvania beautiful.

Highlights

Registered Events and Volunteers - Organizers in Bucks County were leaders in the cleanup effort with 240 registered events followed by Lancaster (225), York (168), Luzerne (160), and Indiana (149) Counties. Volunteers of registered events in these top five counties represented 16% of the total volunteers, accounting for 22,538 of the 137,379 volunteers. This does not include the City of Philadelphia's Philly's Spring Cleanup program which was comprised of an impressive 572 individual cleanup and education events.

- *Pounds of Trash* Volunteers in Philadelphia County collected the most trash with an impressive total of 1,450,500 pounds. Volunteers in Luzerne (668,880), Allegheny (631,420), Bucks (315,060), and Tioga (235,060) Counties rounded out the top five counties for pounds of trash collected.
- *Miles Cleaned* Volunteers in Westmoreland County cleaned more roads, railroad tracks, trails, waterways, and shorelines than any other county with a total of 974 miles cleaned. Volunteers in Bucks (845), Lancaster (723), Chester (583), and Elk (421) Counties rounded out the top five counties for mileage cleaned.
- *Beautification* Beautification efforts were most notable in the southeast region of the state with Philadelphia County volunteers planting a total of 2,753 trees, flowers, and bulbs. Lehigh County volunteers planted 577 trees, bulbs, and flowers and Cambria County planted 480 trees, flowers, and bulbs. The volunteer beautification effort in these three counties accounted for 64% of all trees, flowers, and bulbs planted.
- *Tires collected* York County volunteers collected 16,228 tires followed by Clinton County volunteers with 4,025. Volunteers in Cumberland County collected 3,296 tires. Collections in these three counties accounted for 59% of all tires collected.
