Historical Records Review Checklist

The federal Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) requires public water systems to complete a service line inventory to identify all service lines connected to the water system. As part of conducting this inventory, water systems must review any information available to identify service line materials, including all records identified in the federal LCRR under 40 CFR §141.84(a)(3)(i)-(iv). The following table is meant to guide water systems through completing a thorough records review of all information which may be available to help identify service line material and complete an initial inventory.
