What can be funded?

- Riparian forest buffers
- Lawn conversion to forest or meadow
- Community tree planting, including TreeVitalize

Who should apply?

- County and local governments
- Non-profits with 501(c)(3) and PA Bureau of Charitable Organizations status
- Educational institutions

What is the typical grant size?

- The minimum grant award is \$50,000.
- Match is 20 percent of total project cost.
- One application can support multiple installations and project types.



When are applications accepted?

Grant applications are accepted once each year. The application window opens in January and closes in April. Visit the **DCNR** Grants Customer Service Portal for exact dates
