Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the Pennsylvania Bulletin in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.

Outfall 001 receives wastewaters from the Engine Lab Check & Go, cooling tower and boiler blowdown, non-contact cooling water, steam condensate, RO reject water, Bldg. 60 OWS, and groundwater.

Flow from Outfall 001 goes to a sedimentation basin with an underflow weir and oil skimmer.

No modeling was performed since the discharge consists mainly of NCCW. The source water for the NCCW is from the City of Erie public water supply, which is monitored. The technology-based limits generally given for NCCW will protect the receiving stream.
