Internal Review and Recommendations

This permit was originally drafted on April 21, 2014 and redrafted on May 21, 2015. (See attached fact sheets in Appendix A) No comments were received from the public or EPA during the previous comment period. The operations section noted some minor typographical errors in the previous draft permit. These errors have been corrected in this draft permit. The permittee submitted a letter, dated June 22, 2015, that requested clarification of a few topics. These questions have been answered subsequently and no comment responses are required.

Based on 25 PA Code § 92a.61 and BPJ, monthly monitoring requirements for E. Coli have been added to the draft permit.

The previous effluent limits determination in the original fact sheet is still valid since there have been no significant changes to the receiving stream or discharge. Four (4) quarterly WETT tests were supplied with the application as required by the existing permit. Due to the significant amount of time between the previous draft, addition of monitoring requirements, and the changes to the Part C CSO language, the permit will re-drafted for an additional 30-day comment period.

Additional Long-Term Control Plan (LTCP) Discussion

In order to protect Water Quality Standards (WQS), the Municipal Authority of the City of Sunbury continues to follow the Presumption Approach for CSO compliance. The Municipal Authority of the City of Sunbury has recently submitted a revised LTCP, dated July 15, 2019. The Department hereby accepts and approves this update to the LTCP which outlines progress and planning that has occurred as well as future considerations that are to be evaluated. The permittee has completed all items within the Implementation Schedule outlined in Table 3 of the LTCP and is currently meeting 85% capture. There are still no dry weather overflows occurring and the Authority is in compliance with both the approved Long-Term Control Plan (LTCP) and the Nine Minimum Controls (NMCs).

The Department will require an update to the existing Post Construction Compliance Monitoring (PCCM) plan to meet the requirements listed in EPA's CSO Post Construction Compliance Monitoring Guidance (May 2012). The implementation schedule will be updated to provide 3 years for the permittee to revise their PCCM plan.

The draft permit will contain updated Part C conditions for the management of CSOs.
