Purpose of ApplicationApplication for a renewal of an NPDES permit for discharge of treated sewage					

Internal Review and Recommendations

The first draft of this application appeared in the PA Bulletin on Saturday, July 25, 2020. The final NPDES permit could not be issued due to open violations.

The open violation(s) that prohibited the final issuance of this permit were closed on December 20, 2021.

A second draft of the NPDES permit is being issued because 6 months (or 180 days) have elapsed since the draft has been issued.

The Department was notified via email on September 21, 2020 that the New Jersey Federation of YMHA & YWHA hired Michael Schlank as the CEO effective September 1, 2020. He is the highest-ranking individual at the organization and has the responsibility of the wastewater treatment plant and NPDES Permit. Therefore, the applicant contact was changed from Janet Fliegelman to Michael Schlank for this second draft permit.

Sewage discharges now require monitoring and reporting for E. Coli. A monitoring frequency of 1/month for design flows >= 1 MGD, 1/quarter for design flows >= 0.05 and < 1 MGD, 1/year for design flows of 0.002 – 0.05 MGD will be utilized.

The standard template of the NPDES Permit was revised in August 2021 and has been used for this second draft permit.

Please note that on August 28, 2021, updated NPDES regulations at 25 Pa. Code § 92a.62 related to annual fees became effective. The facility covered by the permit is classified in the Minor Sewage Facility >=0.05 and <1 MGD fee category, which has an annual fee of \$1,000. Invoices for annual fees will be mailed to permittees approximately three months prior to the due date, which is the anniversary of the effective date of your latest new or reissued permit prior to August 28, 2021. Please review Part A of your permit related to annual fees. These annual fees are effective now and may be billed before your draft permit is finalized, unless your facility is exempt from these fees under 25 Pa. Code § 92a.62.
