In accordance with your request received on March 23, 2021, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has transferred the above referenced permit(s). Please study the permit(s) carefully and direct any questions to this office.

The expiration date of the NPDES permit is JULY 31, 2024. If you intend to continue discharging beyond the expiration date, you must submit an application to renew the permit at least 180 days prior to the expiration date.

Enclosed are Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) templates and supplemental forms for your use in meeting the monitoring and reporting requirements of the permit. Your facility is registered to use DEP's electronic DMR (eDMR) system (see www.dep.state.pa.us/edmr). DEP expects that the use of eDMR will continue for the facility. Therefore, the paper DMRs and supplemental forms attached to the permit should be used only for backup purposes. Please contact DEP using the contact information listed on the eDMR website to add new personnel or modify existing eDMR account information.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board), pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:

Appeals must be filed with the Board within 30 days of receipt of notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

The Notice of Appeal form and the Board's rules are also available in braille and on audiotape from the Secretary to the Board.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITH AND RECEIVED BY THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF NOTICE OF THIS ACTION.
