**Internal Review and Recommendations**

A draft permit was prepared on September 11, 2023 and published in the *PA Bulletin* on September 23, 2023 for public comments for 30 days.

During the 30-day public commenting period, US EPA has provided comments on October 11, 2023. In response to these comments, DEP provides the following explanation.

*-During the draft permit review, DEP has performed a whole effluent toxicity analysis (WETT) based on previously submitted WETT reports in 2021 (i.e., latest WET performed before the application submitted). No endpoint failures noted in any of WETT performed during that time. As discussed in the original fact sheet, because there were no endpoint failures, limits will not be included in the permit and the permittee will be performing an annual WET testing as opposed to the quarterly WET testing. The WETT analysis was attached to the original fact sheet but for your convenience, will be re-attached to this fact addendum.*

DEP has not been able to finalize the permit given there are a number of open violations associated with this facility or permittee. All open violations identified by Clean Water Program are now resolved and closed as of January 30, 2026. Given that the draft permit was issued over 6 months ago, it is recommended that the draft permit be republished in the *PA Bulletin* again for public comments for 30 days.
