Internal Review and Recommendations

The NPDES permit for the PA American Water Company's Fairview North treatment plant was renewed on January 10, 2022. After issuance, several errors and omissions were discovered in the renewed permit:

- The 7,375 lb/yr TN offset that was awarded in the renewed permit was erroneously incorporated into the CAP load along with the approved 989 lb/yr CAP load increase. This amendment corrects the error by removing 7,375 lb/yr TN from the CAP load. The following footnote was also added to Part A, Table I.B to clarify the correct use of the offset.
 - 3. The permittee is authorized to use 7,375 lbs/year as Total Nitrogen (TN) offsets toward compliance with the Annual Net TN mass load limitations (Cap Loads), in accordance with Part C of this permit. These Offsets may be applied throughout the Compliance Year or during the Truing Period. The application of offsets must be reported to DEP as described in Part C. The Offsets are authorized for the following pollutant load reduction activities: Connection of 295 on-lot sewage disposal systems to the public sewer system after January 1, 2003, in which 25 lbs/year of TN offsets are granted per connection.
- A quarterly monitoring requirement for E. coli was added to the permit in conformity with the Department's Sewage Effluent Limits SOP. This monitoring requirement was inadvertently not added to the renewed permit.
- The Chesapeake Bay Nutrient Requirements section was added to Part C in full. A truncated version was erroneously included with the last renewal.
