## **Summary of Review**

First draft permit was issued on August 29, 2019 and was published in the PA bulletin on September 14, 2019.

Final permit was not issued because of the compliance issues/violations at the facility identified by DEP operations section. The facility has been working to resolve those issues.

Following are the updates provided by the applicant:

- 1. The current settling basin walls have been extended in height to allow more complete wastewater containment.
- 2. Facility is not currently performing acid wash operations and has no plans in the foreseeable future to do so. However, the facility is in the process of designing a catch basin system to reclaim and recycle this processed water. This system will be constructed and completed prior to resuming acid wash operations
- 3. A swale has been created to control water flow in the yard and divert water to the existing outfalls.
- 4. The facility fuel storage area will be upgraded by purchasing a new fuel storage tank and a precast monolithic catch basin which will act as the secondary containment for the fuel storage tank.

The corrective measures completed, and the proposed plans of the facility hopefully bring the facility in compliance; and we decide to redraft the permit with the following revision:

Oil and Grease limits (average 15 mg/l and Inst.Max. 30 mg/l.) are included in the draft permit based on Chapter 95.2.
