Summary of Review

Henry Thurston-Griswold has submitted an application for a new permit for his proposed Single Residence Small Flow Treatment Facility located in Huntingdon County. DEP received the new NPDES and WQM permit applications on August 8, 2020 by the applicant. The Department has reviewed the application in order to ensure that the facility does not receive or discharge a flow greater than 500 GPD or exceed the specified limits of CBOD5, Total Suspended Solids, Ammonia, and Fecal Coliform prescribed in the permit. As per 25 Pa. Code § 92a.53, all applicable effluent limits and standards are considered in development of the permit. The limits noted in the permit suggest that any applicable water quality standards will not be violated.

The limits discussed in the permit are based off of several factors that were determined by the Standard Operating Procedure for Small Flow Treatment Facilities (SOP No. BCW-PMT-003).

The TSS and Ammonia-Nitrogen limits were prescribed based on The Department's Water Quality Antidegradation Implementation Guidance ID No. 391-0300-002

The Fecal Coliform limits listed in the permit were required by the Bureau of Clean Water, as stated in Chapter 92.2c.b(2) and 93.7.

Based on the review outlined in this fact sheet, it is recommended that the NPDES permit be drafted. Also, it is recommended that the WQM permit be issued upon issuance of the NPDES permit.

Summary of Review

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
