#### **Summary of Review**

The applicant is requesting a new NPDES permit to discharge stormwater associated with an industrial activity. The receiving stream(s), Swabia Creek (HQ-CWF, MF), is located in State Water Plan watershed 2-C and is classified for High Quality-Cold Water and Migratory Fish, aquatic life, water supply and recreation. The receiving stream does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than the designated use and the discharge is not expected to affect public water supplies.

The facility is classified under SIC Code 4151 - Establishments primarily engaged in operating buses to transport pupils to and from school. The PAG-03 General Permit Appendix L contains the site specific best management practices (BMPs) and monitoring requirements for this industrial stormwater classification. The General Stormwater Permit is the minimum standard for all Individual Stormwater permits based on SIC Code.

The requirements will also include prohibition of non-stormwater discharges; Hazardous Substances Release; a PPC Plan; Comprehensive Site Compliance Inspection; Record keeping and Report values for Total Suspended Solids (TSS) and with a 30.0 mg/l limit for Oil & Grease.

A PPC is in place at the facility and it has a grass covered detention basin swale.

Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
