Summary of Review

The applicant is requesting a New NPDES lindividual stormwater permit to discharge stormwater into Bushkill Creek, a High Quality/Cold Water Fisheseek. The receiving stream is _(HQ-CWF/MF) receiving stream in state water plan basin 2-C. A as per the Department's current existing list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than its designated use.

Bushkill Creek is impaired for pathogens and mMercury. Stormwater sampling results report providing with this permit application suggest the stormwater discharge from this Facility is not likely to cause or contribute to the impairment.

Industrial activities in the facility are Warehouse & Storage of snack Feood with trucking activities including m Maintenance and washing. Truck maintenance are is conducted indoors in garage and wash water from washing activities will be collected and disposed off-site.

The facility is primary categorized by SIC code 4213 (Fleet Truck Activities & maintenance) and fall under Appendix L monitoring & reporting requirement of PAG03 general permit. Appendix L pollutant of concernSemi-annual monitoring/reporting is included for

Include Oil & Grease, Total Phosphorus, Total Nitrogen and Total Suspended Solids (TSS).

Anti-degradation:

An Anti-Degradation Module was completed and submitted as part of this permit application. The non-discharge alternatives proposed in the Module are considered infeasible because they are cost prohibitive, technically infeasible, or environmentally unsound. The facility discharge is directed to underground detention basin and will be collected and reused for irrigation.

PPC Plan implementation and completion of an annual inspection and compliance evaluation are required under the permit.

There are currently no open violations for this client that warrant withholding issuance of the permit.


The applicant presented cost effective anti-degradation alternative analysis as this is a new discharge runoff from the drainage area

The High-quality Stream is not expected to be degraded during this permit term because:

- 1-facility discharge is directed to underground detention basin and will be collected and reused for irrigation. Most runoff will
 - infiltrated in the spray irrigation area.
- 2- Discharge from Outfall (001) is unlikely to Bushkill Creek, except in extreme weather event in which case the The permittee is required to monitor and sample during those events.
- 3- Pollution prevention measures in are in place to protect the stream from degradation.

Applicant supplied a Storm water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) which outlined most Pollution prevention measures that will be implemented. Permittee is reminded to update the Plan as necessary.

Summary of Review

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.

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
