### Summary of Review

The applicant is requesting a new NPDES individual stormwater permit to discharge stormwater into UNT to Monocacy Creek, a High Quality-Cold Water Fishes, Migratory Fish (HQ-CWF/MF) in state water plan basin 2-C. As per the Department's current existing list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than its designated use.

Industrial activities in the facility-are include Eengineering and, manufacturing of expansion turbines). Truck maintenance is conducted indoors in a garage and wash water from washing activities will be collected and disposed offsite. This facility is primary categorized by SIC code 3559 (sSpecial Industry Mmachinery & eEquipment) and fall under Appendix U monitoring & reporting requirement of PAG03 general permit. Semiannual monitoring/ reporting are included for pH, Total Suspended Solids (TSS), Oil & Grease, Total Nitrogen, Total Phosphorus, Total Aluminum, Total Iron, Total Zinc and Nitrate+ Nitrite-Nitrogen.

The stormwater leaving the facility drainage is collected in retention basin located in south site of the facility. During high rainfall events any overflow from that basin goes to outfall 001 which direct the stormwater to Bethlehem Township  $S\underline{s}$ torm sewer syste $\underline{m}$  (MS4). (see attached site plan)

A copy of this permit application was sent to Bethlehem Township which own the MS4 system.

## Anti-Degradation:

An Anti- Degradation Module was completed and submitted as part of this permit application. The non- discharges alternatives proposed in this Module were considered infeasible because they are cost prohibited, technically infeasible, or environmentally unsound.

Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the <i>Pennsylvania Bulletin</i> , DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application.
