## Internal Review and Recommendations

Applicant requests renewal of an NPDES permit to discharge stormwater from a small MS4.

According to the requirement, permittee submitted a Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP) for Stony Run.

Permit has a requirement for Appendix B (Pathogens), Appendix E (Sediments) and Appendix C (PCB).

Based on the original submission, DEP issued a comment letter on June 28, 2018. Revised application and PRP were received on August 12, 2019.

The review shows the plan is acceptable.

## Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
