Internal Review and Recommendations

Applicant requests renewal of an NPDES permit to discharge stormwater from a small MS4.

According to the requirement, permittee submitted a combined Plan for Pollutant Reduction for Plum Run, Radley Run, Brandywine Creek, Chester Creek, East Branch Chester Creek, Hunters Run, and Ridley Creek and Total Maximum Daily Load for Goose Creek (Chester Creek).

Permit has a requirement for Appendix B (Pathogens), Appendix E (Sediments) and Appendix F (Phosphorus).

Based on the original submission, DEP issued a comment letter on January 30, 2018. A revised Plan was received on June 14, 2019.

The review shows the plan is acceptable.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
