Internal Review and Recommendations

Per 40 CFR § 122.33, and PA Title 25 § 92a.3, the applicant is required to seek coverage under an NPDES permit issued by the state of Pennsylvania. Due to the applicant's discharge to special protection waters, the applicant has submitted an application for coverage under an individual permit. Per PA Title 25 § 92a.54, the applicant is eligible for permit coverage.

The applicant discharges to the following waters: Pine Run (WWF, MF), Sears Run (WWF, MF), Trindle Spring Run (HQ-CWF, MF), Unnamed Tributary to Conodoguinet Creek (WWF, MF), Unnamed Tributary to Cedar Run (CWF, MF), and Conodoguinet Creek (WWF, MF).

During the previous permit term, the applicant submitted a combined Local Impairment and Chesapeake Bay Pollutant Reduction Plan. The plan was approved on 2/1/2020 and expires 1/31/2025.

There are no unresolved violations associated with the applicant that would affect issuance of coverage.

It is recommended that individual permit coverage is granted in accordance with 40 CFR §123.35.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that
