Internal Review and Recommendations

Per PA Title 25 § 92a.54, since the MS4 discharges to surface water(s) with an existing and/or designated use of EV and/or HQ-CWF, South Middleton Township must seek permit coverage under an individual permit.

South Middleton Township discharges to Alexanders Spring Creek (CWF, MF), Letort Spring Run (HQ-CWF (existing use)), Yellow Breeches Creek (HQ-CWF, MF), and Hogestown Run (CWF, MF).

According to the MS4 Requirements Table, South Middleton Township is subject to the following IP appendix requirements: Appendix D

To comply with Appendix D, South Middleton Township has submitted a Chesapeake Bay Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP).

There are no unresolved violations associated with South Middleton Township MS4 that would affect issuance of coverage.

It is recommended that individual permit coverage is granted in accordance with 40 CFR §123.35.

DEP has reviewed the revised PRP and additional documentation received on 2/26/2021 via email. DEP offers the following comments and recommendations based on the review, which will be evaluated by DEP during the permit term:

1. The plan proposes to retrofit three (3) existing grass swales to bioswales with drainage areas of 84.3 acres, 465.6 acres, and 753.7 acres. While design details are not required at this time, please ensure that the final design adheres to the design guidelines in the Stormwater BMP Manual (or similar resource).

2. Please be advised that the final designs for stream restoration BMPs should be in general accordance with DEP's "Considerations of Stream Restoration Projects" document, available at <u>www.dep.pa.gov/ms4</u>.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
