## **Internal Review and Recommendations**

Per 40 CFR § 122.33, and PA Title 25 § 92a.3, Middlesex Township (the applicant) is required to seek coverage under an NPDES permit issued by the state of Pennsylvania. Due to Special Protection waters, the applicant has submitted an application for coverage under an individual permit. Per PA Title 25 § 92a.54, the applicant is eligible for permit coverage.

The applicant discharges to the following waters: Letort Spring Run (HQ-CWF, MF), Unnamed Tributary to Hogestown Run (CWF, MF), Unnamed Tributary to Wertz Run (WWF, MF), Wertz Run (WWF, MF), Hogestown Run (CWF, MF), Spring Run (WWF, MF), Unnamed Tributary to Conodoguinet Creek (WWF, MF), Unnamed Tributary to Letort Spring Run (HQ-CWF, MF), and Conodoguinet Creek (WWF, MF).

During the previous permit term, the applicant submitted a combined Chesapeake Bay and Local Impairment Pollutant Reduction Plan. The plan was approved on 8/1/2018 and expires 7/31/2023.

There are no unresolved violations associated with the applicant that would affect issuance of coverage.

It is recommended that individual permit coverage is granted in accordance with 40 CFR §123.35.

## **Public Participation**

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application.
