## **Internal Review and Recommendations**

Per 40 CFR § 122.33, and PA Title 25 § 92a.3, Penbrook Borough (the applicant) is required to seek coverage under an NPDES permit issued by the state of Pennsylvania. Due to a TMDL Plan requirement, the applicant has submitted an application for coverage under an individual permit. Per PA Title 25 § 92a.54, the applicant is eligible for permit coverage.

The applicant discharges to the following waters: Unnamed Tributary to Spring Creek (CWF, MF) and Unnamed Tributary to Asylum Run (WWF, MF)

During the previous permit term, the applicant submitted a combined Chesapeake Bay and Local Impairment Pollutant Reduction Plan and a Paxton Creek TMDL Plan. The plan was approved on 9/1/2018 and expires 8/31/2023.

There are no unresolved violations associated with the applicant that would affect issuance of coverage.

It is recommended that individual permit coverage is granted in accordance with 40 CFR §123.35.

## **Public Participation**

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the
