**Internal Review and Recommendations**

Patton Township has submitted an application to renew the existing NPDES permit for its MS4 system.

DEP has received Patton Township's PRP / TMDL Plan Final Report, dated September 30, 2025. The pollutant load reduction requirement was 33,009 lbs/yr total suspended solids. Through one joint stream restoration project, Patton Township was able to secure 36,800 lbs/yr of TSS load reduction. The Millbrook Marsh Stream Restoration Project includes a written agreement between The Pennsylvania State University (PAI134807), Ferguson Township (PAI134805), Borough of State College (PAI134804), Harris Township (PAI134801), College Township (PAI134803), and Patton Township that is identified in the associated joint PRP that allows for sharing of TSS credits between the partners.

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
