Internal Review and Recommendations

The Department received an Individual MS4 NPDES Permit renewal application from Derry Township for coverage of its MS4 on June 2, 2023.

The municipality has outfalls that discharge stormwater to Loyalhana Creek, Saxman Run, McGee Run, Trout Run and Miller Run. Loyalhanna Creek and Saxman Run are designated in 25 PA Code Chapter 93 as warm water fisheries (WWF). McGee Run is designated as Trout Stocking (TSF), Trout Run is designated as a cold-water fishery (CWF) and Miller Run is designated as a high-quality cold-water fishery (HQ-CWF). The Township is subject to an individual MS4 permit because the MS4 discharges to the High-quality stream.

During the last permit cycle Derry Township was subject the Appendix E of the MS4 permit due to discharges to impaired waters for Nutrients and Sediments, requiring the municipality to submit Pollution Reduction Plans (PRPs) to address the impairments and reduce the municipality's contribution and load to the impaired streams within Middle Loyalhanna Creek and the McGee Run HUC-12 watersheds. The PRP was approved by the Department during the last permit cycle. There are no new requirements for permittees with previously approved PRPs; however, the MS4 will need to complete implementation of the approved PRP and submit a final report during this permit term.

The borough has a SW Management Ordinance enacted in December 2020.

The site was last inspected on August 2, 2023, no violations were noted. The Permittee has no open violations.

Permit issuance is recommended.

Internal Review and Recommendations

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
