Purpose of Application		Renewal of NPDES permit for discharge of industrial stormwater.					

Summary of Review

The applicant is requesting a renewal of their NPDES permit to discharge stormwater associated with industrial activity to an Unnamed Tributary to Bushkill Creek, a HQ-CWF, MF (High Quality-Cold Water Fishes, Migratory Fishes) designated receiving stream in state water plan basin 1-F (Jacoby – Bushkill Creeks). As per the Department's current existing use list, the receiving stream segment does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than its designated use.

The facility is categorized by SIC code 3084 (Manufacturing – Plastics, Pipe) and falls under Appendix S monitoring requirements of the PAG-03 General Permit. All industries classified under Appendix S should be within 100 mg/L for Total Suspended Solids (TSS). This value is included as an IMAX limitation and should be sampled semi-annually. Semi-annual monitoring and reporting for pH and Total Zinc are also required under this permit. The pH should be between 6.0 and 9.0. Monitoring and reporting requirements for Total Kjeldahl Nitrogen, Total Phosphorus, Dissolved Iron, CBOD5, COD, and Oil & Grease has been removed from the permit as per updated requirements under Appendix S.

PPC Plan implementation and completion of an annual inspection and compliance evaluation are required under the permit.

A Water Management System Inspection query indicated on January 30, 2020 a Compliance Evaluation was performed.

The previously issued permit expired on May 31, 2021 and the application for renewal was received on time.

There are no open violations for this client that would warrant withholding the issuance of this permit.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*,

Summary of Review

DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
