Summary of Review

The applicant is requesting renewal of an NPDES permit to discharge stormwater associated with an industrial activity to Bushkill Creek a HQ-CWF/MF (Hhigh Qquality - C, cold wWater Fifishesny/, mMigratory Ffishery-designated) receiving stream in state water plan Basin 1-F (Jacoby-Bushkill Creeks). Per the Department's current existing use list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than the designated use.

Stormwater flow both by sheet-flow and thru onsite stormwater conveyance system and discharges through four (04) outfalls to Bush kill Creek to the southwest side (see attachment eMap).

An <u>administrative</u> deficiency notice was sent to the permittee<u>on</u>—March 13, 2023; <u>r-asking for Missing GIF form. Adequate</u> response was <u>r</u>

The facility is classified under SIC Code 3952 - Establishments Perimarily Lendged in Memanufacturing Llead Pencils, Pencil Lleads, and eCrayons; and materials and equipment for artwork, such as, drawing tables and boards, palettes, sketch boxes, drawing inks, and drafting materials and falls under. The PAG-03 General Permit Appendix F of the PAG-03 General Permit Loentains the site-specific best management practices (BMPs) and monitoring requirements for this industrial stormwater classification. Semiannual Memonitoring/reporting requirements are forinclude pH (S.U.), Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD), Total Suspended Solids (TSS), Nitrate-Nitrite as N, Total Phosphorus, Total Nitrogen, Total Aluminum, Total Iron, Total Lead, and Total Zinc.

Benchmarks exist for pH, TSS, COD and Nitrate-Nitrite as N. A benchmark value is the concentration of a pollutant in stormwater discharges that serves as a threshold for the determination of whether existing site BMPs are effective in

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

controlling stormwater pollution. The benchmark values can be found in Part C. V. F. of the permit. A corrective action plan must be submitted to DEP if the discharge concentration for the parameters exceed the benchmark values for two or more consecutive monitoring periods.

A site inspection was performed December 8, 2022-and no violations were found.

A Preparedness, Contingency and Control (-PPC) Plan revised November 2022 was submitted with this application.

TWMS query by client report was run and there are no violations for this client.



Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
