

DEP Announcement - New eDMR System Will Go Live on Monday, December 14, 2015

The E2 system that you currently use for submitting your Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) will be decommissioned by DEP and will be replaced by a new eDMR system effective Monday, December 14, 2015. The new eDMR system resides on [DEP's GreenPort Website](#).

IMPORTANT NOTE – you will no longer be able to use the E2 system starting on Friday, December 11, 2015.

Register for GreenPort Now

All users of the new eDMR system must register for an account through [DEP's GreenPort Website](#). **We encourage you to register immediately** although the new eDMR system will not be available until Monday, December 14. **For information on how to register, please review the [eDMR GreenPort Registration User's Guide](#)**. Transfer of DMRs from E2 to New eDMR System

Only **submitted** DMRs will be transferred from the current E2 System to the new eDMR System. Reports that have not been submitted (i.e., “open reports”) will **NOT** be transferred into the new eDMR System. **If you have started a DMR report in E2, if possible you should submit the report by the end of the day on Thursday, December 10.** If you do not submit an open report by the time the E2 system is shut down, the report will not be transferred to the new system and you will need to re-enter any data saved in the open report.

Go Live Day

On December 14th, DEP encourages all facilities to verify that all reports submitted in E2 have been converted over to the new eDMR system, and that all reports that are due are available and are accurate.
